Frequently Asked Questions

1. Are the lens sizes all the same for the sign projectors?

No, we have 3 different lens sizes. One for our 40W, one for our 100W, and one for our 200/300W. The only interchangeable lens would be between the 200W and 300W as they use the same size lens.

- 2. Is this projector UL Certified? Not currently.
- **3.** Is there a warranty available for projectors? Yes, our projectors have a 5 year warranty. Please contact us, or visit <u>ComplianceSigns.com</u> for more details.
- 4. Am I able to project a sign or crosswalk at an angle instead of straight down, perpendicular to the floor? Yes, we are able to keystone your sign/image to allow images to be projected at angles without appearing to be stretched or distorted.
- 5. How far away can the motion sensor be from the projector? The cord for the Motion Sensor allows for 30ft distance.
- 6. Do I have to rewire my whole warehouse?

No, each projector comes with a 6 foot long 3-prong cord and can be plugged into any standard 110v outlet. Note that the size of your project may work most efficiently if plugs are dropped/wired in above the projector.

- 7. Is the Motion sensor universal with all of your projectors? Yes, it works with all projectors.
- 8. How does toggle switch work?

The opening and closing of a door initiates a change in the image projected, perfect for forklift or pedestrian traffic warnings.

9. Is there a remote?

Remotes are currently only offered for our 40w Sign Projector. For all other projectors, they turn on once they are plugged in and turn off when they are unplugged. To save energy, ask us about our motion sensor option.

10. How do you turn the projectors on and off?

There is no physical on/off switch on the projector. Light switches connected to where the projector is plugged in, and motion sensors, are the two main solutions for projectors not needing to be on 24/7.

11. Is there an additional cost for the Motion Sensor?

Yes, the motion sensor is sold separately.

12. What is the lead time for projectors?

Projectors can take anywhere from 2-4 weeks to arrive, depending on the specifics of the order. Lead times may vary on larger orders.
